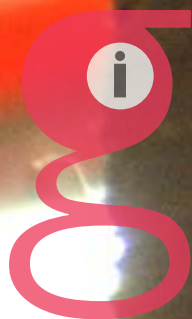
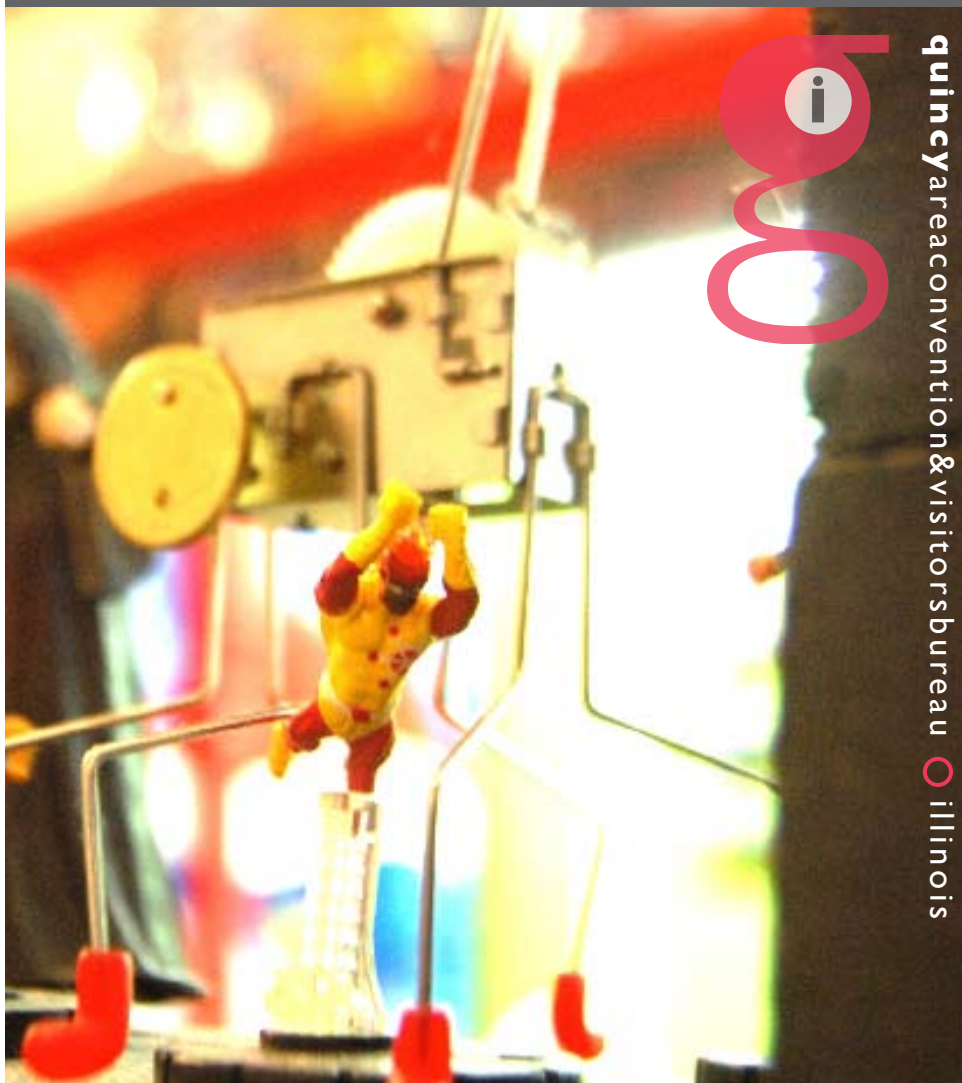

Throughout Quincy, smoking is prohibited in all public areas, including restaurants and bars. Smoking Rooms that register with the City are permitted.

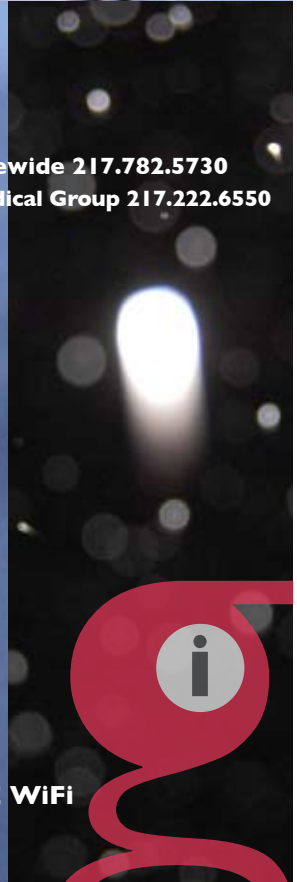
