

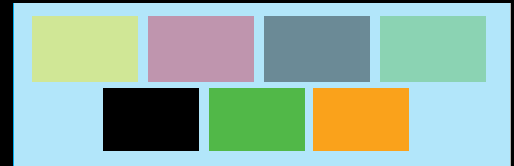

Quincy has **4 National Register Historic Districts** encompassing large geographic areas, noted by color on the map. Over 3,500 structures contribute to these areas. In addition, there are **3 Local Historic Districts** of smaller size.

The Driving Tour guides you through a selection of diverse areas of the city for exposure to a variety of styles. It takes approximately an hour to complete (excluding airport stop #15).

We encourage you to peruse Downtown (the District) & the End Historic District on foot—or via bicycle. **Rent a tandem or trek bike** at the Villa Kathrine (stop #1 on the tour).

**ARCHITECT PROFILE: GEORGE BEHRENSMEYER**

Quincy's first academically trained architect, returned from the Univ of IL fully armed with the Colonial Revival. His first commission, however was the Villa Kathrine, 1900.


