
To celebrate the beauty and power of diversity, we've paired two of the Quincy community's greatest passions: art + food.

The 10-mile route showcases broad sections of the city, and the street art illustrated is as varied as the artists and residents themselves. The course winds through the 6th Street Promenade & the Riverfront. the German Historic District, The District & North End, through the Illinois Veterans' Home and past the Monckton Mansion.

Some of the works are "ghost" murals, weathered by the elements and years, still offering intriguing glimpses of the businesses and families they once represented. Others are new pieces borne of the revitalization initiatives of the city's residents and arts organizations, enlivening the heart of Quincy-The District.

Many of the murals brighten the facades of eateries, creating the perfect fit for a fun and tasty tour. "Dine Finds" are noted throughout the guide (C) indicates those offering curbside pick-up). ENIOY.







DIRECTIONS

Begin at the Villa Kathrine, Tourist Information Center & See Quincy Offices: 532 Gardner Expressway

>Turn Left onto Gardner Expressway (bicyclists: use caution, this is a commercial truck route) follow route past the Civic Center crossing Maine Street into downtown.

MURAL #1 just west of the corner of 4th & Maine.

**MURAL #2** on left side of 4th Street across from Washington Park, just past Maine.

>MURAL #3 also on left side, 4 storefronts down from Focus.



>MURAL #4 across the street at corner of 4th & Hampshire.

>Turn Left on Hampshire Street heading west toward the river. **MURAL #5** located front patio of Tiramisu building.

>Follow Hampshire to the riverfront, turning Right on Front Street. **MURAL** #6 on south side of Chick's on the River building.

Quincy Paper Box | Occupied this building 1928-1991; heart-shaped Valentine boxes were invented and manufactured here | 3RD & VERMONT



>Proceed north on Front Street, turning Right onto Vermont Street. MURAL #7 on north side of Chick's building. Pause at the alley behind Chick's for MURAL #8. The Skyride Inn was established in 1966. Quincyans fondly remember riding the "Skyride" over the Misssissippi from this point on the riverfront to Quinsippi Island.

>Continue east up the bluffs on Vermont Street. MURAL #9 is on your right at the corner of 3rd & Vermont. We love that heart-shaped Valentine boxes were invented and first manufactured here.

>Continue into downtown, passing the Kroc Center and the Adams County Court House. Turn Right on 8th Street to MURAL #10 on the American Legion building.

>MURAL #11 is directly across the street in the alley off of 8th Street.

>Continue south on 8th Street, passing City Hall at 8th & Maine. Stay on 8th to Jefferson Street and Madison Davis Bike Shop. MURAL #12 is located on the corner opposite the bike shop.

>Turn Right at bike shop onto Jefferson and take next Right onto 7th Street, continuing to MURAL #13 on the corner of 7th & State.

>Turn Left on State Street for I block; turn Right onto 6th Street heading back downtown. Stay on 6th to the corner of 6th & Maine, where **MURAL** #14 is inside Grown-N-Gathered and was inspired by the owner's meditation retreat to India.

>Continue through the 6th Street Promenade. Turn Right on Hampshire, **MURAL #15** is on your left on the east wall of Thyme Square Cafe.

>Turn Right on 7th Street, **MURAL #16** is on corner 7th & Maine.

>Turn Left on Maine to **MURAL #17** on corner of 9th & Maine.

>Continue east on Maine to 12th Street, turning Left for 6 blocks, passing the iconic Maid-Rite Sandwich Shop, home of the loose-meat sandwich and featured on Food Network.

>Continue north to **MURAL #18** located on the patio of Hooey's Tavern.

>Continue north on 12th Street 3 blocks to MURAL #19 on your left (on Hooty's Bar & Grill building).

>Continue to 12th & Cedar, turning Left. Turn Right on 8th Street to MURALS #20 & 21. The Coat of Arms represents the Schene & Schnelten families. The deer head = "Emsland", or region the family comes from in Germany. "Halle" = hall; "Heiliger Hubertus" = Heavenly Saint.

In MURAL #21, the "Rattenfanger" = Rat Catcher of Hameln. The fairytale follows the Bubonic plague. The rat catcher was beckoned to play his flute to chase the rats out of town, as it was said that they carried the disease. The children followed him and never returned.

Members of the family currently reside and have an automotive business on the property today.



>Turn Right, heading east on Locust to the sprawling grounds of the Illinois Veterans' Home (the oldest & largest in the state) with monuments, deer park, All Wars Museum & restaurant. MURAL #22 is located in the museum, along with 2 other military-themed works and an impressive wall of military portraits.

>Continue east on Locust passing the Monckton Mansion at 1419 Locust, reputed to be a Mafia safe house with ties to Al Capone. Turn Right on 18th Street, passing Quincy University. Underbrink's Bakery at 1627 College is a 1929 German bakery, beloved for its Angel Food Cupcakes.

>Continue on 18th, turning Left at 18th & Broadway to strip mall on your right: MURAL #23 is inside Taqueria Arandas. Sidewalk riding recommended along Broadway to your final stop at Kelly's happy leprechaun MURAL #24.
