To celebrate art in a big way, we've gathered a set of 24 murals + nearby eats

The 10-mile route showcases broad sections of the city, winding through the riverfront & downtown, the Southside Historic District, North End & German Historic District, and past the Illinois Veterans' Home.

Some of the works are "ghost" murals, weathered by the elements and years, still offering intriguing glimpses of the businesses and families they once represented. Others are newer pieces borne of community revitalization initiatives, enlivening the outdoor atmosphere of public spaces.

Many of the murals brighten the facades of eateries, creating the perfect fit for a fun and tasty tour. "Dine Finds" are noted with each mural entry. If you'd like to bike the tour, give us a ring. The topography is primarily flat, excluding the riverfront hill, and **bike rentals are free** through SeeQuincy.

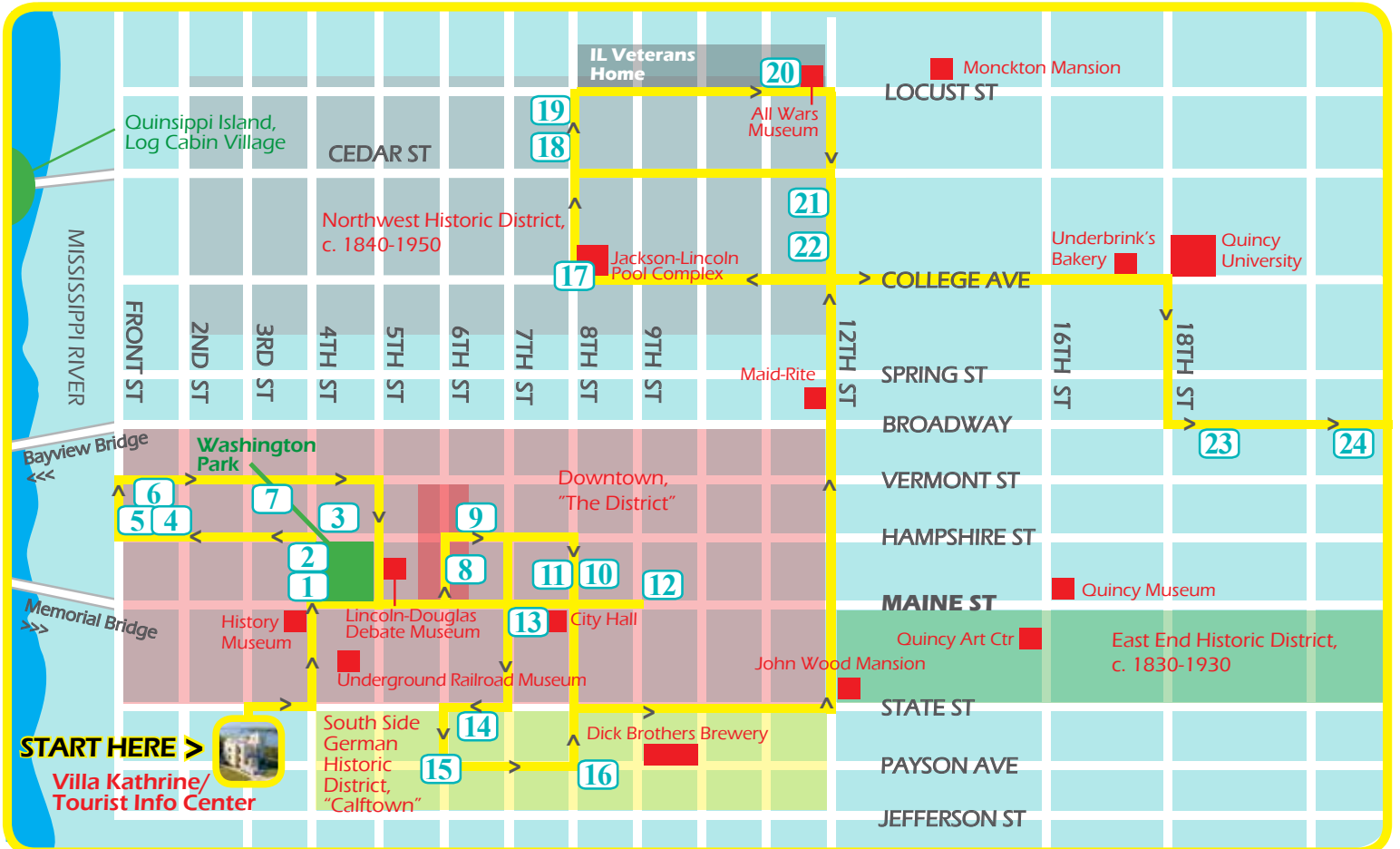

MORE QUINCY, IL ART INFO:

- America's first Arts Council was established here in 1947
- Today, Arts Quincy serves the area representing 55 partner organizations and offers a Celebration of Education Sculpture Series at eight public schools
- Quincy Art Center resides in the East End Historic District as a not-profit art museum celebrating visual arts since 1923
- The City of Quincy is home to the Quincy Public Arts Commission, founded in 2019
- Expedia twice named Quincy as one of the **Most Artistic Towns** in the U.S.
