# inside scoop

## VILLA KATHRINE, c. 1900

- > Mediterranean castle built for world traveler, George Metz at a cost of \$7K
- > Now Tourist Info Center + SeeQuincy offices

## THE HISTORY MUSEUM ON THE SQUARE, c. 1888

- > Quincy's first public library
- > Artifacts, stained glass gallery, Latter-day Saints history, gift shop

## \*LINCOLN-DOUGLAS DEBATE MUSEUM

- > Stories of two influential men in history
- > Across from Washington Park, 1858 Debate site
- \* Museum received a makeover in 2023

## QUINCY UNDERGROUND RAILROAD MUSEUM, c. 1835

- > Home of prominent abolitionist, Dr. Richard Eells
- > Underground Railroad stop #1 east of Missouri

## DICK BROTHERS BREWERY MUSEUM

- > Brewery est. 1857
- > Rare memorabilia of the brewery once larger than Anheuser-Busch
- > Ratskeller Bar in lower level

## JOHN WOOD MANSION, c. 1835

- > Greek Revival home of Quincy's founder and 12th governor of Illinois
- > Cut in half and moved from across the street in 1864

## QUINCY ART CENTER, est. 1923

- > In the historic Lorenzo-Bull carriage house
- > Permanent Collection holds 400+ artworks
- > Hands-on classes + exhibits

## QUINCY MUSEUM, c. 1890

- > 20,000 sq-ft mansion with rotating exhibits
- > 24-karat gold woodwork on first floor

## ALL WARS MUSEUM

- > On the grounds of Illinois' oldest and largest Veterans Home, est. 1886
- > 5,000+ U.S military artifacts / adjoining deer park

## LOG CABIN VILLAGE

- > Dawn to dusk exterior viewings
- > An 1800s Lincoln-era village of 4 log cabins, church, corn crib + stone smoke house

## 1930s AG MUSEUM

- > Private collection located in a rural 20-acre setting
- > 4,000 John Deere and farmstead items on display

## WORLD AEROSPACE MUSEUM

- > On the grounds of Quincy Regional Airport
- > Aircraft from the Cold War era
- > Blue Haven Café located in airport terminal
