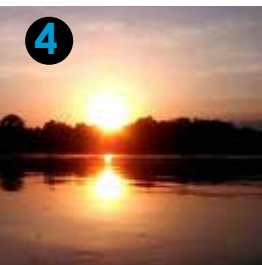


WARSAW BREWERY 900 N 5TH / WARSAW
