Museum ETAILS

- VILLA KATHRINE / Mediterranean castle / c. 1900
 - > Built for world traveler, George Metz at a cost of \$7K
 - > Now Tourist Info Center + SeeQuincy offices
 - THE HISTORY MUSEUM ON THE SQUARE / c. 1888
 - > Quincy's first public library
 - > Artifacts, stained glass gallery, Mormon history, gifts
 - LINCOLN-DOUGLAS DEBATE INTERPRETIVE CENTER
 - > Stories of two influential men in history
 - > Across from Washington Park, the 1858 Debate site
 - DR. RICHARD EELLS HOUSE / c. 1835
 - > Home of prominent abolitionist, Dr. Richard Eells
 - > Underground Railroad stop #1 east of Missouri
- DICK BROTHERS BREWERY MUSEUM / Brewery est. 1857 > Rare memorabilia of the brewery once larger than
 - Anheuser-Busch / New Ratskeller Bar in lower level
 - JOHN WOOD MANSION / Greek Revival / c. 1835
 - > Home of Quincy's founder & Illlinois' 12th governor
 - > Cut in half and moved from across the street in 1864
- QUINCY ART CENTER / est. 1923 / Lorenzo-Bull carriage house
 - > Permanent Collection holds 400+ artworks by regional and national artists / Hands-on classes + exhibits
- QUINCY MUSEUM / Newcomb-Stillwell mansion / c. 1890
- > 20,000 sq-ft showpiece with rotating exhibits
- > 14-karat gold woodwork on first floor
- ALL WARS MUSEUM / 5,000+ U.S military artifacts
- > On the grounds of Illinois' oldest & largest Veterans Home (est. 1886) / Adjoining deer park
- LOG CABIN VILLAGE / Dawn to dusk exterior viewings
 - > An 1800s Lincoln-era village of 4 log cabins, church, corn crib + stone smoke house
- 1930s AG MUSEUM / Private collection on 20 acres
 - > 45-piece John Deere implement display + vintage items typical of a 1930s farmstead
 - WORLD AEROSPACE MUSEUM / Quincy Regional Airport
 - > Aircraft from the Cold War era / The only museum known preserving these types of aircraft in one location
